

Fondation Beyeler Visitor Policies

Dear Visitors,

We wish you a very warm welcome to the Fondation Beyeler and an enjoyable stay. In order to make your visit as pleasant as possible and to ensure the safety and security of visitors and staff as well as the artworks on display, we kindly ask you to respect the following Visitor Policies:

1. Please maintain a safe distance from the artworks at all times. Works of art must not be touched under any circumstances. The museum and the works of art are under video surveillance.
2. For security reasons, luggage items, rucksacks, bags, cases etc. must be deposited in the checkroom. You may take small bags up to A4 size (ca. 20 x 30 cm) into the galleries. Please carry these in front of your body so that they are clearly visible.
Coats and jackets may be worn, but not carried over your arm. Please leave umbrellas in the stands provided in front of the museum. Walking sticks are permitted in the museum, but only when fitted with a protective rubber tip.
3. Large electric mobility aids are unsuitable for use inside the galleries. The Fondation Beyeler staff will be happy to place a museum wheelchair at your disposal upon request.
Large prams and strollers are likewise unsuitable for use inside the galleries. The Fondation Beyeler staff will be happy to place a museum stroller at your disposal upon request.
4. Small children must be held by the hand in the exhibition.
5. Out of consideration for other visitors, please do not conduct cell phone conversations anywhere inside the museum.
6. Non-flash photography with cell phones and compact digital cameras is permitted for personal, non-commercial purposes only. In exceptional cases where a particular artwork may not be photographed, a notice to this effect will appear beside the artwork. Flash, tripods, professional photography equipment and selfie sticks are not permitted.
7. You may write and draw inside the museum in pencil only. Please use a suitable notepad or notebook. Ballpoint pens, color and felt pens, brushes, scissors, etc. are not permitted.
8. Tours led by outside guides, and the use of tour-guiding systems, are not permitted in the museum. To book a group tour, please contact our Tours department on +41 61 645 97 20 or by email at fuehrungen@fondationbeyeler.ch.
9. Touching or climbing on the outdoor sculptures in the museum gardens is not permitted. Please note that these sculptures are under camera surveillance.
10. No animals are permitted in the museum (except for seeing-eye dogs).
11. No food or drink may be consumed in the museum.
12. Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the museum.

By entering the museum, you accept these Visitor Policies and all further regulations designed to ensure the safety and security of persons and artworks in the museum.

Our security personnel are responsible for ensuring that these Visitor Policies are upheld. Please assist them in their work and follow their instructions.
