

## **Fondation Beyeler Visitor Policies**

### **Visits by School Classes**

Welcome to the Fondation Beyeler!

The following Visitor Policies are designed to make your class trip to the Fondation Beyeler as pleasant as possible and to ensure the safety and security of visitors and staff as well as the artworks on display. As a teacher, you are responsible for the behavior of your pupils. We would therefore ask you to read out and explain our Visitor Policies to your class before you visit the museum and to follow the instructions of our security personnel while you are here. Thank you for your co-operation and your understanding.

1. Please note that visits by school classes must be booked with the Fondation Beyeler in advance.
2. We welcome school groups up to a maximum of 25 persons (including teachers).
3. School classes must be accompanied by at least one teacher at all times. We are unable to admit unsupervised school classes to the museum.
4. Please make sure that all members of your group wear the Fondation Beyeler stickers you are given. This will help our staff to identify you as an official group.
5. Bags/rucksacks and jacket/coats must be deposited in the checkroom before you start your visit. Umbrellas should be left in the stands provided in front of the museum.
6. All the pictures are equipped with alarm sensors. Please ensure that the members of your group do not get too close to any of the works of art.
7. Touching or climbing on the outdoor sculptures in the museum gardens is not allowed. Please note that these sculptures are under camera surveillance.
8. No food or drink may be consumed in the museum.
9. Non-flash photography with cell phones and compact digital cameras is permitted. In exceptional cases where a particular artwork may not be photographed, a notice to this effect will appear beside the artwork. Tripods and selfie sticks are not permitted.
10. The use of laser pointers in the museum is not permitted.
11. Drawing is allowed in the museum, but only with pencil. Please use a suitable notepad or notebook. Ballpoint pens, color and felt pens, brushes, scissors, etc. are not permitted. Pencils can be obtained from the checkroom.
12. Please keep all passages clear so as not to obstruct other visitors.
13. The General Visitor Policies are expressively reserved.
